### OSTARA AND HER SISTERS

*Ostara* and *Eastre* are the High German and Anglo-Saxon versions of a word which appears in modern English as "Easter". Both words point to an earlier Common Germanic form \**Austron*, apparently the name of a pagan goddess. But who is *Ostara*/*Eastre*/*Austron*? One clue comes from the fact that Anglo-Saxon *Eastre* and English *Easter* are related to "east," the direction of the sunrise. In Latin and Greek *Ostara*'s sisters are *Aurora* and rosy-fingered *Eos*, both containing variants of the root word of \**Austron*, both goddesses not of Spring but of Dawn.

Another of *Ostara*'s sisters is *Ushas*, the goddess of Dawn in the Hindu *Rig Veda*. *Ushas* rides a chariot in an endless race with *Ratri*, the star jeweled Night goddess. At the spring equinox *Ushas* pulls ahead, and light lasts longer than darkness until the beginning of autumn, when she inevitably falls behind *Ratri* again during the long, cold winter season.
